3 Eggs (large - enough monture)

15 oz. Dried Mixed Fruit

Grated rind of small Orange

1. Cream margarine and sugar, gradually add lightly beaten

2. Fold in flour, salt and spice, add mixed fruit and orange

rind.

3. Place in a deep 8" cake tin.

Bake in centre of a moderate oven (325-350° F., gas mark 3—4) for $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours approx.

CLASS 2. VICTORIA SANDWICH

4 ozs. Margarine

4 ozs. S.R. Flour

4 ozs. Caster Sugar

2 Eggs

1. Cream margarine and sugar until light and creamy in

2. Add egg a little at a time and beat well. Gently fold-in

3. Place mixture into a greased 7" cake tin or two 7" sandwich tins.

5. When cool, split and fill with jam or cream.
