## RECIPE SHEET

### Section A

#### CLASS 1. APPLE TART ON A PLATE

Shortcrust pastry top and bottom, apples in between.  
Any size plate, no decoration, i.e. leaves.  
Finish, brush with egg white or cold water and  
sprinkle with caster sugar.

---

#### CLASS 2. VICTORIA SANDWICH

4 ozs. Margarine                      4 ozs. S.R. Flour  
4 ozs. Caster Sugar                  2 Eggs

1. Cream margarine and sugar until light and creamy in texture.
  2. Add egg a little at a time and beat well. Gently fold-in flour.
  3. Place mixture into a greased 7" cake tin or two 7" sandwich tins.
  4. Bake in moderate oven (325—350° F., gas mark 3—4).  
25—30 minutes in two tins.  
40—45 minutes in one tin.
  5. When cool, split and fill with jam or cream.
