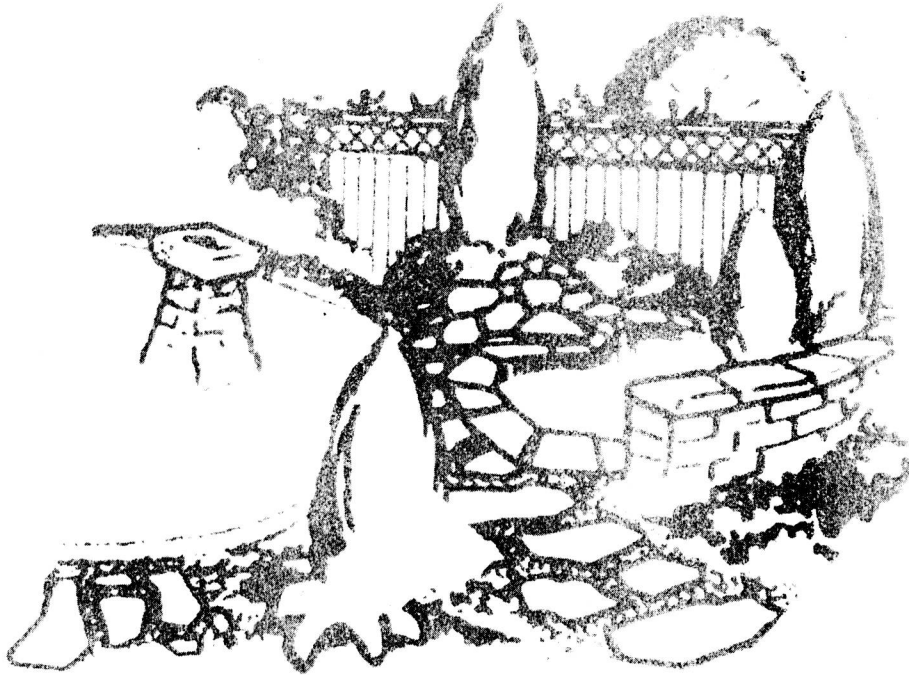

## RECIPE SHEET

Section A

### CLASS 1. APPLE TART ON A PLATE

Shortcrust pastry top and bottom, apples in between.  
Any size plate, no decoration, i.e. leaves.

Finish, brush with egg white or cold water and sprinkle  
with caster sugar.

### CLASS 2. VICTORIA SANDWICH

|                     |                    |
|---------------------|--------------------|
| 4 ozs. Margarine    | 4 ozs. S. R. Flour |
| 4 ozs. Caster Sugar | 2 Eggs             |

1. Cream margarine and sugar until light and creamy in texture.
2. Add egg a little at a time and beat well. Gently fold-in flour.
3. Place mixture into a greased 7" cake tin or two 7" sandwich tins.
4. Bake in moderate oven (325 350 F., Gas mark 3-4)  
25 - 30 minutes in two tins.  
40 - 45 minutes in one tin.
5. When cool, split and fill with jam or cream.

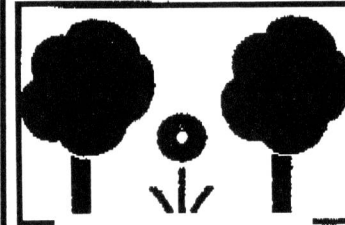

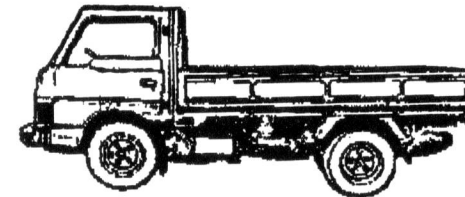
