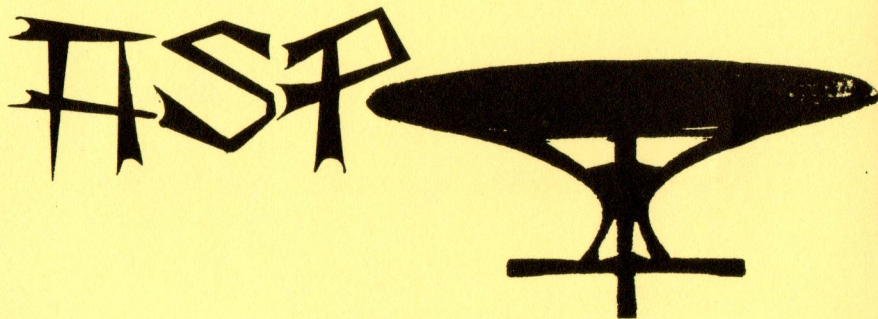

2. Everything entered must be grown or made by the Exhibitor, except flowers used in the floral arrangements.
3. An entry fee of 20p will be levied for each entry. Children aged 16 years and under, free section 0 only.
4. Entry forms and entry fee of **20p** for each entry to be taken to the Village School, Elsworth, on Thursday 3rd and Friday 4th September between 7.00pm - 9.00pm prior to the Show.
5. Exhibits must be brought to Elsworth School between **7.00 pm and 9.00 pm** on Friday 4th September or between **8.00am and 10.00am** on Saturday 5th september.
6. **Exhibits must not be removed before 4.00pm** on the day of the show. The Committee will be very grateful for any exhibits left for auction after 4.30pm.
7. Exhibitors may make more than one entry in any one class. Each exhibit must be accompanied by an entry form and appropriate fee.
8. Exhibitors must provide own plates, vases etc. as they require. The Committee will not be responsible for any breakage or loss of such items.
9. Each class may be judged 1st, 2nd, 3rd.

FIRST - 50p
SECOND - 30p
THIRD - 20P
Certificates will be awarded to those achieving a First in each childrens class

THE RULES

10. Where the entries are less than four in any one class, the awarding of more than one prize will be at the discretion of the judge.

RECIPE SHEET

Section A

CLASS 1. APPLE TART ON A PLATE

Shortcrust pastry top and bottom, apples in between.

Any size plate, no decoration, i.e. leaves.

Finish, brush with egg white or cold water and sprinkle with caster sugar.

CLASS 2. VICTORIA SANDWICH

4 ozs. Margarine 4 ozs. S. R. Flour
4 ozs. Caster Sugar 2 Eggs

1. Cream margarine and sugar until light and creamy in texture.
2. Add egg a little at a time and beat well. Gently fold-in flour.
3. Place mixture into a greased 7" cake tin or two 7" sandwich tins.
4. Bake moderate over (325 350 F., Gas mark 3-4
25 - 30 minutes in two tins
40 - 45 minutes in one tin.
5. When cool, split and fill with jam or cream.
