





- 5. Exhibits must be brought to Elsworth School between 7.00 pm and 9.00 pm on Friday 4th September or between 8.00am and 10.00am on Saturday 5th september.
- **6. Exhibits must not be removed before 4.00pm** on the day of the show. The Committee will be very grateful for any exhibits left for auction after 4.30pm.
- 7. Exhibitors may make more than one entry in any one class. Each exhibit must be accompanied by an entry form and appropriate fee.
  - **8.** Exhibitors must provide own plates, vases etc. as they require. The Committee will not be responsible for any breakage or loss of such items.
    - 9. Each class may be judged 1st, 2nd, 3rd.

# Section A

# CLASS 1. APPLE TART ON A PLATE

Shortcrust pastry top and bottom, apples in between. Any size plate, no decoration, i.e. leaves. Finish, brush with egg white or cold water and sprinkle with caster sugar.

# **CLASS 2. VICTORIA SANDWICH**

4 ozs. Margarine

4 ozs. S. R. Flour

4 ozs. Caster Sugar

2 Eggs

- 1. Cream margarine and sugar until light and creamy in texture.
- 2. Add egg a little at a time and beat well. Gently fold-in flour.
- 3. Place mixture into a greased 7" cake tin or two 7" sandwich tins.
- 4. Bake moderate over (325 350 F., Gas mark 3-4

25 - 30 minutes in two tins


40 - 45 minutes in one tin.

5. When cool, split and fill with jam or cream.




