- 5. Exhibits must be brought to Elsworth School between 7.00pm and 9.00pm on Friday Ist September or between 8.00am and 10.00am on Saturday 2nd September
- Exhibits must not be removed before 4.00pm on the day of the show. The Committee will be very grateful for any exhibits left for auction at 4.30pm.
- 7. Exhibitors may make more than one entry in any one class. Each exhibit must be accompanied by an entry form and appropriate fee.
- 8. Exhibitors must provide own plates, vases etc. as they require. The Committee will not be responsible for any breakage or loss of such items.
- 9. Each class may be judged 1st, 2nd 3rd. Prizes awarded:

Certificates will be awarded to those achieving a First in each children's class.
